CONTRACT

Hackett Catholic Central **requires** all students to participate in the three major components of the Faith-Formation Program :

- Academic theology class
- Faith-experiences of prayer, liturgies, retreat
- Service projects connected to theology class

Through these components, our students grow in communal faith-formation, grow in knowledge of God, faith related areas, and teachings and traditions of the Church; develop leadership skills; and, learn to serve God through serving others. Therefore, we ask that parents and students support our faith-formation programs and sign this contract and fully understand the policy requirements of participating in the life of the Hackett Catholic community.

*During class retreat dates, NO WAIVER WILL BE GRANTED giving precedence to any appointment, meeting, college visit, or any special off-campus programs. Please check the school calendar for these **priority dates**. We also understand that in order to receive **academic credit** for graduation or promotion to the next level, a student must successfully pass the theology class academic requirements, complete all service projects hours, and attend a retreat approved by Campus Ministry.*

This contract once signed and dated by both parent/guardian and student is in effect for all the semesters attended while a student at Hackett Catholic Central.

New students in the 10th, 11th, 12th grades... the contract can be dropped off in the Main Office at the time of the "used book sale" or the registration process. Freshmen fill out and sign form at "Freshmen Orientation" in August. **All contracts must be on file: no later than first day of classes – September 5, 2006.**
